







In-Home & Out-of-Home Respite Care

xavier Children's Support Network has developed a variety of in-home and out-of-home respite options in recognition of families' individual respite needs.

Families can be assisted with respite in their own homes by:

-  Being given financial assistance to pay for a carer who the family has identified; or
-  Having a trained Support Worker from Xavier's Community Team care for their child in the family's own home.

Families can also be assisted with overnight out-of-home respite through:

-  Being given financial assistance to pay for a carer who the family has identified; or
-  Xavier's Structured Family Respite option where children are cared for in a home environment by an Xavier employee who has been trained to care for young children with complex disabilities
